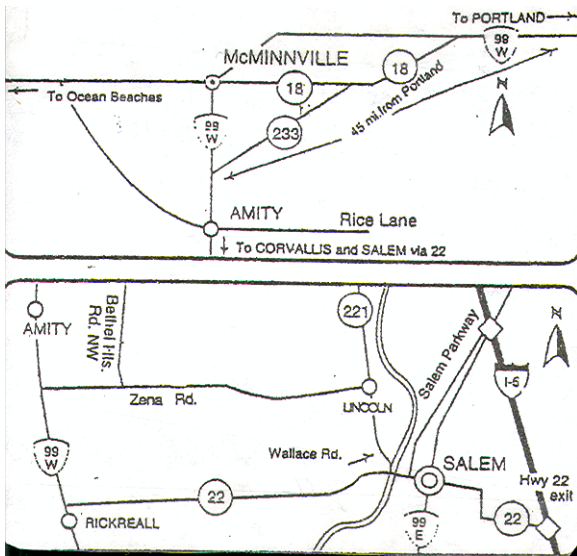

Amity is located 7 miles south of McMinnville. From Portland, it is 45 miles south on 99W. From Salem, take Hwy. 22 to Rickreall, then north 11 miles on 99W. From Hwy. 18 go east on Bellevue, (by Lawrence Gallery) for 6 miles.

Starting at Amity Elementary School
300 Rice Lane Amity, OR 97101

Daffodil Farm: 6K, 10K, 12K or 15K rated 2, Out & back on paved country road with gradual hill. Meanders thru small community seeing Wineries, Fire Station, local Cemetery, & Pioneer church. With views of rolling hillsides and lovely farmland. A shuttle will be offered from 9-11:00am for the 6K walk. 12K will be on Bethel Rd. on quiet country road through farm area. 15K includes daffodil farm, Bethel Rd., returning through town.
