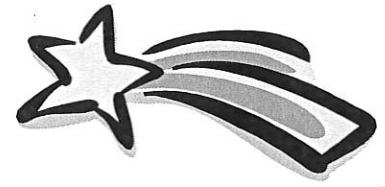
Amity Elementary School will invite students and families to participate in school activities:

Amity Elementary School will work with families to create a school environment that is accessible to all Amity families:

- Host monthly Amity Parent and Teachers Together (APaTT) meetings
- Encourage family participation with emphasis on families of underserved populations

- Translate materials and mailings
- Identify barriers, if any, to family participation in school activities and design strategies for more effective family involvement
- Provide a translator, when applicable
- Pay reasonable expenses associated with family involvement activities
ie. offer child care or snacks
- Support families in transition



Amity Elementary School will provide information, materials, and training to help parents work with their child to improve academic achievement.

Provide families with:

- information on state standards and assessment
- their child's performance on state assessments
- time to formally meet with their child's teacher (*parent/teacher conferences*)
- web based resources available on the district website
- tips and activities for work at home

Amity Elementary School staff will communicate with parents and Head Start, the Amity Community Preschool, and the WESD to coordinate and facilitate transition into kindergarten.

Amity Elementary School will annually review and evaluate the effectiveness of the family engagement plan in improving the school's educational program.

- Invite families to the annual meeting to discuss and suggest revisions to improve the current plan
