- ✓ **All** applications must be accompanied with a signed statement who your parent or guardian has reviewed your complete application.
- ✓ Your application must be received prior to the deadline established for submittal.

How to Use & Print the AHS Fillable Scholarship Application

1. Create a new file folder, make this your destination for all of your scholarships.
2. Download the scholarship file, save the scholarship in the folder you have just created. You will be accessing and using the newly saved scholarship.
3. Open the scholarship that has been saved to your new folder. If you fill in the application directly after opening it from the website nothing that you type in will be saved. You have to: Open/Download/Save/Re-open.

It is recommended that you use Google Docs to write your essays and create your activity lists; then copy/paste into your application.

Amity Creative Arts Scholarship

The Amity Creative Arts scholarship was established in memory of Ted Affolter, a talented musician, to provide financial assistance to a graduating senior who plans to further his/her education at a university, college, or art school. The student must pursue a degree in music performance, music education, art history, drama, photography, fine arts or visual arts.

Selection criteria

This scholarship will be based on quality of the application, involvement in extracurricular activities, and financial need.

The recipient:

1. Shall be a senior and have been enrolled in Amity schools for a minimum of two years.
2. Shall submit a transcript with a cumulative 3.00 GPA or higher at the end of the 7th semester.
3. Shall submit two letters of recommendation- one from a music/art instructor and one from an Amity School District employee.
4. Shall enroll in a community college, university, or art school the fall term following their graduation from high school.
5. Shall submit a portfolio of their creative art work completed (a minimum 5 pieces) in the past year or CD of music/theatrical performance.
6. Shall submit an essay of no more than 500 words stating why you want to pursue a career in the arts. In this essay, please include a personal reflection on the submitted art work.
7. **Shall complete the attached scholarship application along with the required items submitting it to the ASPIRE Coordinator no later than 3pm on March 12, 2020.**

Amount of Scholarship

One \$1000 scholarship shall be awarded when an appropriate candidate meets the criteria. Payment will be made to the respective college or university business office after a registration receipt is received at the Amity School District Office.

Selection Committee

The selection committee shall be consistent with the donor's request through the Amity School District Foundation. Additionally, a member of the Affolter Family will preview and provide input regarding the final 2-3 candidates.
