- ✓ All applications must be typed and proofed to ensure neatness, proper spelling and correct grammar.
- ✓ The application must include all of the requested materials or it will not be accepted.
- ✓ **All** questions must be answered **clearly and completely**, using complete sentences. (It is highly recommended that you provide all pertinent information that helps to clarify your response.)
- ✓ **All** applications must be accompanied with a signed statement that your parent or guardian has reviewed your complete application.
- ✓ Your application must be received prior to the deadline established for submittal.

How to Use & Print the AHS Fillable Scholarship Application

1. Create a new file folder, make this your destination for all of your scholarships.
2. Download the scholarship file, save the scholarship in the folder you have just created. You will be accessing and using the newly saved scholarship.
3. Open the scholarship that has been saved to your new folder. If you fill in the application directly after opening it from the website nothing that you type in will be saved. You have to: Open/Download/Save/Re-open.

It is recommended that you use Google Docs to write your essays and create your activity lists; then copy/paste into your application.

Ariel Dumler Memorial Scholarship

A scholarship has been established for Amity High School seniors in memoriam of Ariel Dumler, to honor her encouragement for higher education and her love and dedication to sports, and shall be maintained by Amity School District 4J. It is the desire of the committee to provide a scholarship to two Amity High School students who have been active in sport(s) and club(s) while maintaining a 3.0 GPA or above during their high school years.

Students seeking to apply for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Attended Amity High School all four years.
2. Have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Please attach an unofficial transcript. (request this in advance from the High School Head Secretary)
3. Be involved in at least one sport per year (for every year that sports were offered at the high school). If you had plans of doing a sport, but were injured and still a part of the team you can still apply.
4. Plan to be attending a community college, 4 year college, or vocational school.
5. A student will enroll in some form of post-secondary education the fall term following his and her graduation from Amity High School.
6. Provide 2 letters of recommendation, one from a coach and one from a community member or teacher, both not related to you.
7. Be naturally responsible.
8. Exhibit good citizenship.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarships will be granted on the basis of: quality of application, academic excellence, achievement and involvement in extracurricular activities, including sports and citizenship. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

The scholarship amount will be \$750, given to one female and one male. There will be a runner up candidate for each of these just in case the recipient doesn't go to college the fall after graduating from high school. The scholarship shall be awarded the recipient's first college year with payments being made to the respective business office on behalf of the recipient, upon a registration receipt being received by the Amity School District office.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee shall consist of a Amity High School Teacher, the Superintendent, a Amity High School coach (past or present), and the Amity High School counselor. Additionally, members of the Dumler family will preview or provide input regarding the final 4-6 candidates.

Applications are to be completed and returned to the ASPIRE Coordinator on or before February 23, 2023 by 3:00 pm.
