- ✓ **All** applications must be accompanied with a signed statement that your parent or guardian has reviewed your complete application.
- ✓ Your application must be received prior to the deadline established for submittal.

How to Use & Print the AHS Fillable Scholarship Application

1. Create a new file folder, make this your destination for all of your scholarships.
2. Download the scholarship file, save the scholarship in the folder you have just created. You will be accessing and using the newly saved scholarship.
3. Open the scholarship that has been saved to your new folder. If you fill in the application directly after opening it from the website nothing that you type in will be saved. You have to: Open/Download/Save/Re-open.

It is recommended that you use Google Docs to write your essays and create your activity lists; then copy/paste into your application.

4. Enroll at a Certified Trade School, Community College, College or University. If the recipient is not enrolled in a Certified Trade School, Community College, College or University by the Fall term following his/her High School graduation, the award will go to the runner-up.
5. **Submit a completed application to the ASPIRE Coordinator no later than 3pm on February 24th.**
