Pallett Memorial Scholarship

The Pallett Memorial Scholarship has been established to provide financial assistance to a graduating senior who plans to further her/his education at an accredited college or university.

The funds for this scholarship have been made available in memoriam of Dave Pallett, to honor his encouragement with higher education, and shall be maintained by Amity School District 4J, placing the funds in an interest bearing CD or Money Market in the local First Federal Savings & Loan to draw the maximum interest.

Selection Criteria

Scholarships will be granted on the basis of: quality of application, academic excellence, achievement and involvement in extracurricular activities, citizenship and financial need.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The recipient:

1. Shall be a senior and have been enrolled in Amity schools for a minimum of three years at the time of submitting the application form.
2. A student will be eligible for 25% of the full amount for each year he/she attended Amity High School.
3. Shall submit a transcript with a cumulative 3.25 GPA or higher at the end of 7th semester.
4. Shall complete the attached scholarship application form (handwritten),
5. Shall submit three letters of recommendation – at least one from a non-related community resident such as employer and at least one from an Amity School District employee.
6. Shall enroll in a community college or a 4-year university/college the fall term following his/her graduation from high school.

Amount of Scholarship

One \$500.00 scholarship shall be awarded the recipient's first college year with payments being made to the respective business office on behalf of the recipient, upon a registration receipt being received by the Amity School District office. Equal payments will be made on a quarterly/semester basis, whichever is in place at the institution, upon the receipt being submitted, as noted.

Continuation of a \$500.00 per year scholarship will be awarded to the recipient until his/her college graduation (or four years total, whichever comes first) contingent upon recipient maintaining at least 12 credit hours per term and a 3.0 GPA with an official transcript being filed with the Amity School District office, when sending the registration receipt. If no recipient is elected on a given year, the Committee may consider two recipients for the following year with each scholarship being the initial \$500.00. **Scholarship awards are contingent on available funds.**

Selection Committee

The selection committee shall consist of two regular Amity High School Teachers, the Superintendent, and either the High School Principal or Vice-Principal. Additionally, a member of the Pallett Family will preview and provide input regarding the final 3-5 candidates.
