- ✓ All applications must be accompanied with a signed statement that your parent or guardian has reviewed your complete application.
- ✓ Your application must be received prior to the deadline established for submittal.

How to Use and Print the AHS Fillable Scholarship Applications Online

1. Download and save the scholarship normally
2. Go to your file folder; click on “downloads”
3. Right click on the scholarship that you have saved - click on “OPEN WITH” - click on “Adobe Reader” - you can now fill in your information, cut/paste, print, or save

You will have to open the scholarship with Adobe Reader every time you want to use it.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

Jim and Lynda Nyseth is offering this scholarship to encourage and assist Amity High School seniors who wish to further their careers by attending a trade school or joining an apprenticeship program. This scholarship will pay for tuition, books, fees, tools or any expense needed to start their careers.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The scholarship will be granted on the basis of: quality of application, achievement and involvement in extracurricular activities, citizenship and financial need. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

The student:

1. Is a senior enrolled at Amity High School for at least 2 years.
2. Will complete the scholarship application and provide financial information.
3. Will enroll in some form of post-secondary education or apprenticeship the fall term following his/her graduation from high school.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Funds will be made payable to the educational institution or of their choice or directly to them for expenses (tools, etc). Receipts will need to be subitted.

A letter outlining how to access funds will be provided when the scholarship is awarded.
