

McMinnville Grange Scholarship

A \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded to a Yamhill County high school graduate who is entering an agricultural or related field/veterinarian field.

1. The student must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA (2.75 GPA for community college).
2. The student must be enrolling as a full time student (12 credits) in an accredited vocational or degree school in the fall of 2022.
3. The student must have been a participant in various school and agricultural related activities.
4. The student must submit 2 personal letters of recommendation.
5. The student must submit a letter of recommendation from school counselor or school advisor.
6. The student must submit a current transcript with this application.
7. Student finalists will be asked to give a short presentation of their future career plans at a Grange meeting.
8. Scholarship will be sent directly to school upon proof of enrollment.
